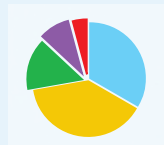

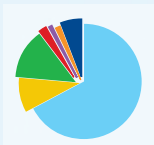

Locations

With three strategically placed locations and online opportunities, SCF is accessible to students 24/7/365.

SCF Bradenton: The 100-acre campus is in southwest Manatee County and convenient to both counties. It is home to the Neel Performing Arts Center, Howard Studio Theatre, Fine Art Gallery, athletic fields and gymnasium.

SCF Venice: Our 100-acre campus on South Tamiami Trail is equal distance from Venice, Englewood and North Port. The Professional Development Center and engineering technology lab highlight enhancements to this scenic campus.

SCF Lakewood Ranch: Our 10-acre site in Lakewood Ranch Corporate Park borders Sarasota and Manatee counties. The Center for Innovation and Technology is popular for trainings and seminars. A Medical Technology and Simulation Center includes state-of-the-art simulation technology, labs and classrooms.

SCF Online: A full A.A. degree and many other classes are available online. All bachelor's degrees are available online.
