For the purpose of assessing fees a student shall be classified as a Florida resident or a non-Florida resident/out-of-state student.

1. In order to be classified a Florida resident, for tuition purposes, a student shall file a residency affidavit and submit all required documentation. In the absence of the required affidavit and documentation, the student shall be classified as a non-Florida resident/out-of-state student.
2. Non-Florida residents will be required to pay non-resident tuition fees in addition to the matriculation fee required of all students.
3. A non-Florida resident of appropriate age after having been a resident and domiciliary of Florida for twelve (12) months may apply for and be granted reclassification prior to the first day of classes for the term in which residency reclassification is sought provided that appropriate documentation has been submitted.

Certain exceptions are permitted through federal programs and in Florida Statutes for applicants who do not meet the 12-month legal residence requirements for classification as a Florida resident. Appropriate documentation is required for all circumstances.
