The award of college credit (from regionally accredited institutions) shall be based on standards of good practice in accordance with the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, the American Council on Education, the American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers, and the National Association of Foreign Student Administrators. Coursework taken on a noncredit basis will be awarded when there is documentation that the noncredit coursework is equivalent to a designated credit experience. Prior learning is evaluated by the appropriate faculty member who assesses students in approved courses to validate their specialized knowledge. Methods of assessment include written, oral and performance tests; portfolios that describe and document learning and how it was acquired; interviews with faculty members; and evaluation of certificate and/or licenses.
