



Academic Calendar Summer 2018

March 5, Monday	Web registration begins for all active students (including dual enrollment) continuing for Summer 2018 classes with 45+ earned credit hours.
March 6, Tuesday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for Summer 2018 classes with 30–44 earned credit hours.
March 7, Wednesday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for Summer 2018 classes with 15–29 earned credit hours.
March 8, Thursday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for Summer 2018 classes with 0–14 earned credit hours.
March 12, Monday	Web registration begins for all new students (including dual enrollment) transfer, transient, readmits, and all others not previously registered for Summer 2018 classes.
April 2, Monday	First day financial aid standards of satisfactory academic progress (SAP) appeals for the Summer 2018 term will be accepted for students who were NOT enrolled for the Spring 2018 term.
April 23, Friday	All required documents must be received by the Financial Aid Office to ensure funding of tuition and fees at the beginning of the summer terms (for all Summer A, B, and C terms). Documents received after this date will be processed in the order they were received by the Financial Aid Office. Students should pay for their classes by the established pay dates as reimbursement will be made based upon eligibility.
May 1, Tuesday	Deadline to have FASFA application on file to be considered for priority-based funding for Fall 2018 term. All tuition and fee payments due for all Summer 2018 term classes (includes class registrations for all Summer A, B, and C terms). All Summer 2018 class schedules not secured with full payment or financial aid by 11:59 p.m. will be cancelled for non-payment.

May 7, Monday

Spring 2018 grades posted to academic transcripts.

Last day for students to submit third-attempt fee waiver forms for Summer A and C courses.

First day to use financial aid in the SCF Store (for all Summer A, B, and C terms).

Financial aid standards of academic progress (SAP) status will be available on MySCF for students enrolled in Spring 2018 term.

First day financial aid standards of satisfactory academic progress (SAP) appeals will be accepted for students who were enrolled in Spring 2018 term.

All institutionally approved grants, loans, and scholarships exceeding tuition and fee charges will be available to pay for books and supplies. Students should review their account balance online to verify fund availability.

May 11, Friday

Last day new student applications (including readmission applications) will be accepted for Summer A and Summer C terms.

Last day placement testing offered to new students for Summer A and Summer C terms.

Last day for submission of residency documentation for all Summer A and C terms.

Last day of new-student orientations for Summer A and Summer C terms.

May 14, Monday

Summer faculty return.

Summer 2018 classes begin for Summer A and Summer C term courses.

May 15, Tuesday

All required documentation must be received and placement testing completed for all dual enrollment and early admission students at both the high school campus as well as SCF for the Fall 2018 term.

May 24, Thursday

Last day for students to change degree/program/major for the Summer 2018 term. All changes after this date will be effective for the Fall 2018 term.

May 25, Friday	Last day to use financial aid in the SCF Store (for all Summer A, B and C terms).
	Last day to change course from credit to audit for Summer A and Summer C term classes.
May 28, Monday	Memorial Day. College closed.
June 1, Friday	Last day to submit an application for Summer 2018 graduation.
June 6, Wednesday	Financial aid census date for the Summer 2018 term. Total credit hours registered on this date will be used to establish financial aid eligibility. All future class registrations after this date will not be eligible for federal financial aid for the Summer 2018 term.
June 18, Monday	Last day for students to submit third-attempt fee waiver forms for Summer B classes.
June 20, Wednesday	All charges due SCF will be deducted from the disbursement of student loan funds for first time borrowers and the remaining balances will be available on student SCF OneCard accounts.
June 20, Wednesday	Summer 2018 A classes end.
June 21–25, Thursday–Monday	Exams (Summer A).
June 25, Monday	Last day new student applications (including readmission applications) will be accepted for Summer B term.
