Academic Calendar Spring 2017

- October 24, Monday Web registration begins for all active students (including dual enrollment) continuing for spring 2017 classes with 45+ earned credit hours.
- October 25, Tuesday Web registration begins for all active students continuing for spring 2017 classes with 30 – 44 earned credit hours.
- October 26, Wednesday Web registration begins for all active students continuing for spring 2017 classes with 15 – 29 earned credit hours.
- October 27, Thursday Web registration begins for all active students continuing for spring 2017 classes with 0 – 14 earned credit hours.
- October 31, Monday Web registration begins for all new students (including dual enrollment) transfer, transient, readmits and all others not previously registered for spring 2017 classes.
- First day Financial Aid Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) appeals for the spring 2017 term will be accepted for students who were NOT enrolled in fall 2016 term.
- November 4, Friday Deadline to submit the **graduation attendance form** online to guarantee participation in December 16, 2016 Winter Commencement ceremonies.
- November 11, Friday **Veterans Day. College closed.**
- November 14, Monday All required documents must be received by financial aid to ensure funding of tuition and fees at the beginning of the Spring term. Documents received after this date will be processed in the order they were received by the financial aid office. Students should pay for their classes by the established pay dates if funding is not in place at that time.
