Summer 2019

March 4, Monday	Web registration begins for all active students (including dual enrollment) continuing for Summer 2019 classes with 45+ earned credit hours.
March 5, Tuesday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for Summer 2019 classes with 30–44 earned credit hours.
March 6, Wednesday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for Summer 2019 classes with 15–29 earned credit hours.
March 7, Thursday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for Summer 2019 classes with 0–14 earned credit hours.
March 11, Monday	Web registration begins for all new students (including dual enrollment) transfer, transient, readmits, and all others not previously registered for Summer 2019 classes.
April 1, Monday	First day financial aid standards of satisfactory academic progress (SAP) appeals for the Summer 2019 term will be accepted for students who were NOT enrolled for the Spring 2019 term.
April 19, Friday	All required documents must be received by financial aid to ensure funding of tuition and fees at the beginning of the Summer terms (for all Summer A, B and C terms). Documents received after this date will be processed in the order they were received by the financial aid office. Students should pay for their classes by the established pay dates as reimbursement will be made based upon eligibility.
May 1, Wednesday	Deadline to have FASFA application on file to be considered for priority based funding for Fall 2019 term. All tuition and fee payments due for all Summer 2019 term classes (includes class registrations for all Summer A, B, and C terms). All Summer 2019 class schedules not secured with full payment or financial aid by 11:59 p.m. will be cancelled for non-payment.
May 6, Monday	Spring 2019 grades posted to academic transcripts.

Last day for students to submit third attempt fee waiver forms for all Summer terms.

First day to use financial aid in the SCF Store (for all Summer A, B, and C classes).

Financial aid standards of satisfactory academic progress (SAP) status will be available on MySCF for students enrolled in Spring 2019 term.

First day financial aid standards of satisfactory academic progress (SAP) appeals will be accepted for students who were enrolled in Spring 2019 term.

May 10, Friday

Last day new student applications (including readmission applications) will be accepted for Summer A and Summer C classes.

Last day placement testing offered to new students for Summer A and Summer C classes.

Last day for submission of residency documentation for all Summer A and C classes.

Last day of new student orientations for Summer A and Summer C classes.

May 13, Monday

Summer faculty return.

Summer A and Summer C courses begin.

May 15, Wednesday

All required documentation must be received and placement testing completed for all Dual Enrollment and Early Admission students at both the high school campus as well as SCF for the Fall 2019 term.

May 24, Friday

Last day to use financial aid in the SCF Store (for all Summer A, B, and C courses).

Last day to change course from credit to audit for Summer A and Summer C classes.

May 27, Monday

Memorial Day. College Closed.

May 31, Friday	Last day to submit an application for Summer 2019 graduation.
June 3, Monday	Last day for students to change degree/program/major for the Summer 2019 term. All changes after this date will be effective for the Fall 2019 term.
June 5, Wednesday	This is the first census date. Changes to course registration (adding/dropping) beyond this date, may impact financial aid eligibility
June 19, Wednesday	Summer A classes end.
June 20–24, Thursday– Monday	Exams (Summer A).
June 24, Monday	Last day new student applications (including readmission applications) will be accepted for Summer B classes. Last day placement testing offered to new students for Summer B classes. Last day new student orientations for Summer B courses. Last day for submission of residency documentation for all Summer B courses.
June 25, Tuesday	Final grades due at noon for Summer A courses and all other courses ending by June 25. Summer 2019 classes begin (Summer B).
June 26, Wednesday	Summer A grades posted to student transcripts.
July 1, Monday	All required documents must be received by the Financial Aid Office to ensure funding of tuition and fees at the beginning of the Fall 2019 term. Documents received after this date will be processed in the order they were received by the Financial Aid Office. Students should pay for their classes by the established pay dates as reimbursement will be made based upon eligibility. First day financial aid standards of satisfactory academic progress (SAP) appeals for the Fall 2019 term will be accepted for students who were NOT enrolled in Summer 2019 term.
July 4, Thursday	Independence Day. College closed.

July 5, Thursday	Last day to change course from credit to audit for Summer B classes.
July 29, Monday	Summer C classes end.
July 30-31, Tuesday–Wednesday	Exams (Summer C term).
August 1, Thursday	Summer B classes end.
August 5–6, Monday– Tuesday	Exams (Summer B).
August 8, Thursday	Final grades due at 2:00 p.m. for Summer B and C classes and all other courses ending by August 7.
August 9, Friday	Summer grades posted to student transcripts.
