Academic Calendar Spring 2019

October 1, Monday	Web registration begins for all active students (including dual enrollment) continuing for spring 2019 classes with 45+ earned credit hours.
October 2, Tuesday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for spring 2019 classes with 30 – 44 earned credit hours.
October 3, Wednesday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for spring 2019 classes with 15 – 29 earned credit hours.
October 4, Thursday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for spring 2019 classes with 0 – 14 earned credit hours.
October 5, Monday	Web registration begins for all new students (including dual enrollment) transfer, transient, readmits and all others not previously registered for spring 2019 classes.
October 31, Wednesday	First day Financial Aid Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) appeals for the spring 2019 term will be accepted for students who were NOT enrolled in fall 2018 term.
November 12, Monday	All required documents must be received by financial aid to ensure funding of tuition and fees at the beginning of the Spring term. Documents received after this date will be processed in the order they were received by the financial aid office. Students should pay for their classes by the established pay dates if funding is not in place at that time.
November 30, Friday	All required documentation must be received and placement testing completed for all dual enrollment and early admission students for the spring 2019 term.
December 3, Monday	All tuition and fee payments due for spring 2019 term classes.
December 17, Monday	Financial Aid Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) status will be available on SCF Connect for students enrolled in fall 2018 term.

January 2, Wednesday	Last day for students to submit third attempt fee waiver forms for spring 2019 classes.
January 3, Thursday	Faculty return. Last day placement testing offered to new students for classes that begin January 7-11. First day Financial Aid Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal (SAP) forms will be accepted. All institutionally approved grants, loans and scholarships exceeding tuition and fee charges will be available to pay for books and supplies. Students should review their account balance online to verify fund availability.
January 4, Friday	Last day of new student orientations for spring 2019 classes starting January 8 -13. Last day for submission of residency documentation for Spring 2019 term.
January 7, Monday	Spring 2019 classes begin.
January 11, Friday	Last day to change course from credit to audit status.
January 19, Friday	Last day to use financial aid in the bookstore. Last day to submit an application for spring 2019 graduation.
January 21, Monday	Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday. College closed.
January 22, Tuesday	Last day for students to change degree/program major for Spring 2019 term. All changes after this date will be effective for the summer 2019 term.
January 23, Wednesday	Financial aid enrollment census date for the spring 2019 term. Total credit hours registered on this date will be used to establish financial aid eligibility. All future class registrations after this date will not be eligible for federal grants for the spring 2019 term.

February 11, Monday	An “I” grade not previously completed from the fall 2018 term will be changed to an “F” on the student’s permanent record.
February 15, Friday	Faculty Professional Development Day. No day credit classes or labs. Credit classes starting after 4:00 p.m. will meet as scheduled.
March 4-8	Spring Break for students and faculty. Corporate and Community Development classes and selected services may be open on the weekend preceding and following the weekday Spring Break. Check the SCF website for details.
March 29, Friday	Deadline to submit the <i>graduation attendance form</i> online to guarantee participation in May 3, 2019 Spring Commencement ceremonies.
April 1, Monday	First day Financial Aid Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) appeals for the summer 2019 term will be accepted.
April 21, Monday	All required documents must be received by financial aid to ensure funding of tuition and fees at the beginning of the summer 2019 term. Documents received after this date will be processed in the order they were received by the financial aid office. Students should pay for their classes by the established pay dates as reimbursement will be made based upon eligibility.
April 26, Friday	Spring classes end. Honors Convocation, 12:30 p.m. SCF Venice, 7:00 p.m. Neel Performing Arts Center, SCF Bradenton.
April 29-May 2	Final examinations for spring 2019 classes.
May 3, Friday	Final grades due at 2:00 p.m. for all spring 2019 classes. Spring Commencement, Bradenton Area Convention Center, 7:00 p.m.
May 6, Monday	Spring 2019 grades posted to student transcripts.
May 8, Wednesday	Financial Aid Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) status will be available on SCFconnect for students enrolled in spring 2019 term.
